Saa Sita informed us that, along with his wife, they decided to care for an orphan whose mother was recently killed by terrorists in the bush. Then late February we had further news sent by SMS as it was happening ... "bandits came at midnight and were killing people and we are running away". We received more news and photos of those killed including a corpse of one of the terrorists!!

However, the following morning the school opened and classes resumed! Saa Sita wrote "I'm preparing the way to school. Really this has become normal and children are going to school and we are safe". Our prayers indeed do matter – God is at work and answers prayer in ways we never imagined possible!
